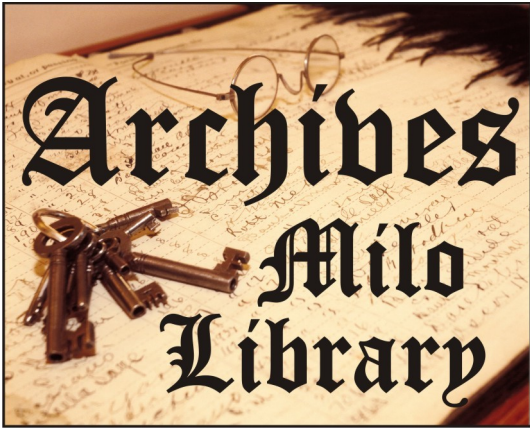


Library & Archives Hosts a Milo Memories Night
